#### A New Approach to the TMJ, Functional Occlusion and the Face

We have all heard the argument. Does the occlusion cause the joint problem or does the joint cause the occlusal problem? What role do facial patterns and the muscles play? This lecture takes many of the current concepts in these somewhat confusing disciplines and organizes them in a way so that most practitioners can comfortably differentiate the etiology of occlusal disease, diagnose temporomandibular joint disorders and predict long-term success for the restored or non-restored dentition.

#### OBJECTIVES:

Upon completion of this course, participants can expect to have gained knowledge on the following concepts;

1. How to differentiate between iatrogenic, foundational and transient occlusal disorders.
2. The use of diagnostic imaging and testing to aid in diagnosis
3. The role of the airway and skeletal patterns with regard to diagnosis and treatment.
4. The appropriate treatment and sequencing based on etiology of the condition.
5. Tips, tools and materials used within these disciplines.

#### Biography: Jeff Horowitz, DMD

Dr. Jeff Horowitz, a native of Old Bridge, New Jersey, completed his undergraduate studies at the University of Pittsburgh and earned his DMD degree from the Medical University of South Carolina. Upon graduation he completed a general practice residency at the Mountainside Hospital in Montclair, NJ. In 1992, Dr. Horowitz founded the Carolina Center for Cosmetic and Restorative Dentistry, a multi-disciplinary group practice in the Conway/Myrtle Beach, SC area. His main interests include cosmetic smile rehabilitation, complex restorative cases, treatment of sleep disordered breathing, orthodontics and TMJ disorders. An admitted C.E. "Junkie", Dr. Horowitz has earned fellowship from the Academy of General Dentistry where he is actively involved as a past-president and delegate for South Carolina. He also serves as a mentor at the prestigious Kois Center for Advanced Dental Studies, a key opinion leader/lecturer for the Catapult Group, and an instructor for Sleep Group Solutions. His affiliations include the Pierre Fauchard Academy, the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry, the American Orthodontic Society, the American Dental Association, the American Association of Dental Sleep Medicine, the Carolina Sleep Society, American Equilibration Society, and the American Academy of Craniofacial Pain.
